REQUEST UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002 (FOISA)

Thank you for your request dated 22nd November 2021 under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA).

Your request

You asked the following:

- 1) What is the LNG tank capacity for both Hulls 801 and 802?
- 2) Please confirm the total journey length that can be made by either Hull 801 or 802 on one full tank of LNG?
- 3) What is the projected amount of methane slip from the LNG-powered engines of Hulls 801 and 802?
- 4) What is the marine diesel tank capacity for both Hulls 801 and 802?
- 5) Please confirm the total journey length that can be made by either Hull 801 or 802 on one full tank of marine diesel?
- 6) How long does it take to operate a full switchover from marine diesel to LNG or vice versa for Hulls 801 and 802?
- 7) How much gas is required to vent Hulls 801 and 802 to switch over from LNG to Marine Diesel? What percentage of the gas involved is methane? How far from the harbour does the venting operation take place?

Response to your request

Please find our response to your request for information:

Questions 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7 relate to the operation of the ferries. This is outside Ferguson Marine's remit and we do not have any information that relates to these matters.

- 1) The LNG tank capacity of both 801 and 802 is 148.30m³. Good practice under IMO rules is to fill to a maximum of 95%, giving an effective capacity of 140.885m³ which equates to 57.42 tonnes of fuel.
- 4) The diesel (MGO) tank capacity of both 801 and 802 is 144.50 m³. At 95% this capacity is 137.275m³ which equates to 118.06 tonnes of fuel.
